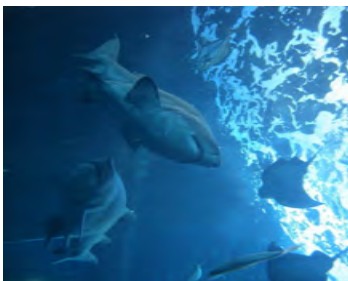

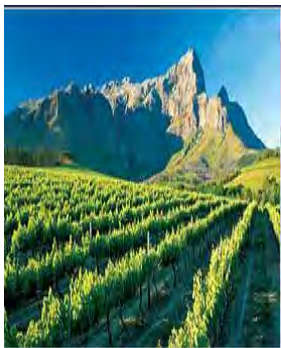
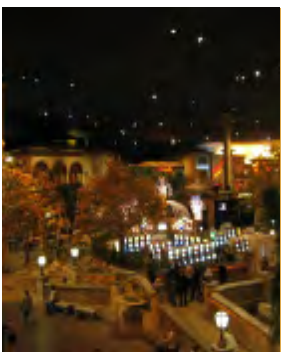
Day 1: Robben Island or Table Mountain Tour (choose either tour)

DAY 11

SWAZILAND

DAY 1

Depart by road for the Kingdom of Swaziland and arrive at Ezeluini Hotel just in time to freshen up before heading off for a delicious, authentic African lunch at Malendelas Farm. Spend the rest of the afternoon exploring the captivating Swazi culture at the Mantenga Cultural Village.

DAY 2

Start the morning with a trip to the King Sobhuza Museum followed by a fascinating visit to the Ngwenya Glass Factory where you'll discover how old glass bottles are transformed into beautiful ornaments. Relax over lunch in verdant gardens followed by a drive through the picturesque countryside back to Johannesburg.

NAMIBIA

DAY 1

Windhoek (or Swakopmund) - Namib Desert

» Depart early afternoon, travelling via the scenic Spreetshoogte Pass or Kuiseb Canyon and Solitaire.

» Arrive at the lodge, your tranquil escape in the Namib Desert. Namib means 'vast', an apt word to describe the Namib Naukluft Park, one of world's largest conservation areas, characterised by endless burnt-orange dunes whipped into razor-sharp ridges by merci less winds.

» Dine in the desert under a diamond canopy of countless stars in an inky black sky.

DAY 2

Namib Desert

» Rise early to experience dawn in stark but scenic Sossusvlei, the Namib Naukluft Park's most popular attraction. The cracked, scorched sands of the circular, parched pan shimmer silvery in the midday heat, surrounded by towering, ochre red and orange dunes. Then, if the desert hasn't sapped all your strength, choose a guided drive across the dunes as the golden sun slips behind orange sands.

DAY 4

Namib Desert - Windhoek (or Swakopmund)

» After breakfast, return to Windhoek or Swakopmund via Remhoogte Pass or Kuiseb Canyon, arriving at your accommodation around midday.
